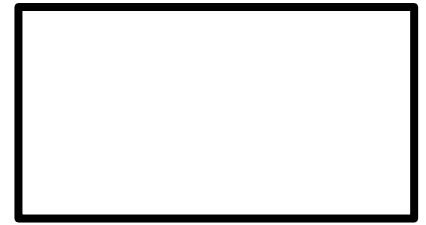


Confirmation of use for renting a mountain cart



By providing their signature and personal data, the person renting the cart confirms and accepts the following points:

Requirements for driving

- **Helmet requirement:** Only ride with a helmet! You can bring your own helmets. Alternatively, disinfected rental helmets are available.
- According to the manufacturer, the **maximum permissible weight for the driver of a mountain cart is 100 kg** and must not be exceeded.
- **Children from 1.35 m tall** are allowed to ride a mountain cart themselves. The prerequisite is the consent, liability and supervision of the legal guardian(s) or the adult supervisor throughout the entire loan period.
- Wear sporty, comfortable clothing, (sunglasses) and sturdy shoes.

Behavior while driving

- Place your **feet firmly on the footrests** throughout the descent.
- Always **brake with both brake** levers at the same time!
- Perform a **brake test** immediately upon starting to drive at low speed to test the brakes and become familiar with the mountain cart.
- Drive at a **controlled speed** so that you can stop safely at any time.
- Tilt your upper body towards the inside of the curve **“Lean into the curve”**.
- Reduce driving speed before corners. If you corner too quickly, the mountain cart can tip over or swerve, like any other vehicle.
- Racing, driving in a group, reversing, jostling, and tailgating are prohibited.
- **Keep enough distance** from the mountain cart in front and from the edge of the road.
- Always expect pedestrians, cyclists or Alpine cattle along the entire route.
- Make sure that **no loose/bulgy clothing**, bags, etc. can get into the tires/brakes while driving. Check that nothing can fall out of your pockets.
- Do not leave the marked route and follow the signs.
- Dismount before electric fence passages (the crossbars could hit your face).

Prohibited is

- Taking children under 1.35 m with you
- Mountain cart driving under the influence of alcohol.
- Taking animals with you

Further information

- Always park mountain cart safely so that it cannot roll away.
- In the event of technical problems, stop the journey immediately and report the problem to the railway staff.
- The instructions of the railway staff are followed at all times.
- The mountain cart can only be rented against a deposit.
- **In an emergency, dial 112**

Liability

- Driving the mountain carts is at your own risk, i.e. Alpenbahnen Spitzingsee GmbH excludes any liability for accidents, loss of items, damage to property, etc.;
- Driving mountain carts is generally only permitted to the extent that the driver does not endanger himself or other people or property;
- Each driver is liable for all damage that he culpably causes (including damage to the mountain cart itself);
- If one of the above points is violated, Alpenbahnen Spitzingsee GmbH is entitled to immediately demand the mountain cart back from the borrower and to prohibit further travel. There will be no (proportional) refund of the rental fee.
